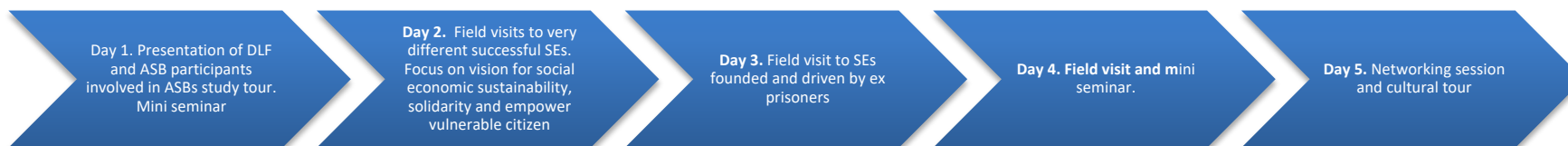

Day 2. Field visits to successful social organization and SEs

- **Settlement.** <http://settlementet.dk> Based on a vision for social economic sustainability and solidarity, the Settlement works to include vulnerable people, and meet and overcome the urban, social and economic challenges of their everyday life in the municipality. They help and interact with the local social authorities, and initiate activities, which include and empower people. By running several activities in two streets they involve and help more than 1.000 citizens per year. The activities cover counseling, meeting support, as well as cafes, shops, recycling activities, festival and street events. It is all part of a social economic approach to the problems and challenges of the community. By supporting their wellbeing, training skills and competences, a sense of empowerment is gradually developed. The Settlement has around 100 volunteers and 50 employees.
- **People Like Us.** <https://peoplelikeus.dk> Hiring of people with different degrees of autism in a brewery. This company is not petucarelary working with ex prisoner but is highly interested because of its social business concept and its founder's comprehensive knowledge as social entrepreneur.

Day 3. Field visit to successful SEs, founded and driven by ex-prisoners, hiring and helping other ex-prisoners and citizen on the edge

- **Friendsandfood.** Catering company. <http://www.friendsnfood.dk> Friends & Food is founded by Mikkel Fries and Mikkel Gyldenløve Thomsen, who together have 15 years of experience in the restaurant industry. When Friends & Food folds out, it is with great passion and with the desire to send their guests' taste buds on a journey they will soon forget. One of the founder is an ex prisoner with a very troubled baggrund. Now they are doing CSR helping other ex prisoners even that the compagny is very small.
- **Eco House.** <http://www.oko-huset.dk> This project is foundet and driven by a ex gang leader. Martin Christian Celosse- Andersen is also political involved with change of law and governements programs who do not have much effects on exit programs for gang members. The Ecohouse is a project in which M.C.A, based on health in the form of dietary guidance and physical activities / training, help people who, for various reasons, find themselves in a marginalized position / period of their lives. M.C.A. is in addition to his role as project manager, also life coach and work for e.g. with organic diet and nutrition as a therapeutic tool in daily lifestyle. Together with 8 voulentary mentors, they have chosen to jointly establish "Isabella's garden" which consists of an organic garden, containing eco greenhouse of about 22 m2, 6 high beds and a garden area in addition to about 100m2, in a property in Naestved, which is called the Ecohouse and which is inhabited by several of the volunteer assistants involved in DAV.

- **Café Exit.** Field visit <https://cafeexit.dk/om-os/about-cafe-exit/> Café Exit is an association targeted at people released from prison and at prisoners, who during imprisonment have decided to make a fresh start. The work consists of a number of different initiatives: • informal time together • employment guidance • dept counselling • talk therapy with therapist or psychologist

The aim is to create new networks and help prisoners and released people to live an active life without crime.
- **Mini seminar by 3F** who is the biggest trade union federation, in Denmark, that organizes unskilled and vocationally trained employees.
